Important Notices

- If your IBCLC certification expired in 2011 or if you are a first time exam applicant, this is not the correct supplement for you. Please visit <http://www.americas.iblce.org/apply-for-the-iblce-exam> for the correct information.
- Email is the primary way in which IBLCE communicates with recertifying by exam applicants. It is your professional responsibility to notify IBLCE of any change to your email address. In addition, please add iblce@iblce.org to your Safe Senders list so as to minimize the possibility of emails from IBLCE going to your junk mail folder.
- Applications postmarked after the deadlines specified in this Supplement will be subject to additional fees. **Please Note:** The final postmark deadline is April 30, 2012. Do not mail your application materials after April 30 before contacting IBLCE in the Americas.
- All fees are payable to IBLCE in US dollars **only**. Checks or money orders payable in other currencies, including Canadian dollars, will be returned and the applicant charged an Incomplete Application fee.
- Declined credit cards and checks returned for non-sufficient funds will be subject to a \$50USD fee for each occurrence.
- To receive the discount associated with the February 28 deadline, your application form(s), supporting documentation, payment form and payment must be postmarked by no later than February 29, 2012.
- Applicants who fail to submit the correct form(s) and fee(s) will be notified in writing of their ineligibility to take the IBLCE exam.
- Recertifying IBCLCs who need to change their exam site location must notify IBLCE in the Americas by email by no later than June 15. Only those requests that are based on **documented** extraordinary circumstances will be considered after June 15.
- Recertifying IBCLCs who need to withdraw or cancel their plans to take the exam must notify IBLCE in the Americas by mail, fax or email no later than June 20. Requests dated no later than June 20 will receive a partial refund of exam fees.

- Requests made **after** June 20 must be addressed by mail, fax or email to the Regional Director no later than August 31, 2012 and accompanied by documentation of extraordinary circumstances. Only those requests that are based on **documented** extraordinary circumstances and are postmarked by August 31, 2012 will be considered for an extension of certification.
- IBCLCs must recertify every 5 years and recertification by exam is mandatory every 10 years. If you are due to recertify in 2012 and fail to do so, your IBCLC certification will expire on October 31, 2012.

Exam Fees

Fees are established on the basis of average income for health professionals in each country and countries are placed one of 3 tiers/groups. Two application postmark deadlines are offered, with the February 28 deadline offering a discounted fee. The countries in the Americas region fall into 2 of the country tiers/groups.

Tier 1: Canada and the United States {High Fee Countries}

Tier 2: None {Medium Fee Countries}

Tier 3: Caribbean nations, Central American countries, Guam, Israel, Mexico, Puerto Rico and countries of South America {Low Fee Countries}

The following tables show the 2012 Recertification Fees for Tier 1 and Tier 3 countries. All fees are in US dollars.

- **Please Note:** Applications postmarked after the deadlines listed below and incomplete applications are subject to additional fees.
 - IBCLC in the Americas will return checks/money orders payable in other currencies, including Canadian dollars, and the applicant will be charged an Incomplete Application fee. Credit card payments made in other currencies will be converted to US dollars and the applicant will be responsible for any currency conversion rate charges.

Payment

Applicants must complete all sections of the Recertification by Exam Payment Form and submit the completed form along with payment by one of the following methods:

- **credit card**
 - The Recertification by Exam Payment Form must include all of the following information
 - credit card number
 - expiration date
 - verification code
 - cardholder's name, address and phone number
 - cardholder's signature

- Fees must be paid in US dollars. Credit card payments made in currencies other than US dollars will be converted to US dollars and the candidate is responsible for any exchange rate fees incurred.
- **check or money order**
 - Must be drawn on a USA-bank and made payable to IBLCE in US dollars.
 - Checks or money orders payable in other currencies, including Canadian dollars, will be returned and the applicant will be billed for an Incomplete Application fee.

Payment by someone other than the recertifying IBCLC will be accepted. Information about the person or organization making the payment must be included on the Recertification by Exam Payment Form.

- **Please Note:** If someone other than the recertifying IBCLC makes payment, refunds and receipts will be made to the person or organization that paid the fees, not to the IBCLC. There are no exceptions to this rule.

You are responsible for full and prompt payment of fees. If either your application or your payment is postmarked after the postmark deadlines specified in this Supplement, you will be invoiced for the difference in fees and you will be given a deadline by which to submit the additional fees. In the meantime, your application will not be reviewed for eligibility.

- **Please Note:** Applications received without payment will not be processed. Candidates who fail to pay the exam fee in full as specified by the postmark deadline will be subject to additional fees.
 - IBLCE staff will not finalize eligibility determination until payment, including any additional fees, is received in full.

Checks returned for insufficient funds and declined credit cards are subject to a \$50.00USD service fee.

- **Please Note:** A separate service fee will be charged for each notice of insufficient funds and/or each occurrence of the credit card being declined.

Receipts for the exam fees paid will be sent with the exam eligibility letter.

Payment by Employers: Some, but not all employers, pay for their employees to take the IBLCE exam. If your employer is paying your exam fee, you must coordinate payment so that your application form(s) and the payment are postmarked by the deadlines specified in this Supplement. You, not your employer, are responsible for prompt and timely payment. You, not your employer, will be invoiced for additional fees if your application and payment are not postmarked by the deadlines specified.

- **Please Note:** Because 2012 is a leap year, your application form(s), payment form and payment must be postmarked by no later than February 29, 2012 in order to receive the discounted fee associated with the February 28 postmark deadline.

Refund Policies

Recertifying IBCLCs who follow the withdrawal/cancellation procedures and applicants who are denied eligibility to take the 2012 exam will receive a partial refund of fees paid. You should allow 4 to 6 weeks for the partial refund to be processed.

Withdrawal/Cancellation Policies

Applicants who decide to withdraw from taking the exam must send a written request by mail, email or fax. Only the applicant can request the withdrawal, the request must be in writing and it must be postmarked by no later than June 20, 2012. Withdrawal requests that meet these requirements are eligible for a partial refund.

- Furthermore, withdrawal requests based on documented extraordinary circumstances must be sent to the Regional Director via mail, email or fax by no later than August 31, 2012. Only those requests that are postmarked by August 31, 2012 and include documentation of extraordinary circumstances will be considered.

Financial Assistance

Scholarships are available through the Monetary Investment for Lactation Consultant Certification (MILCC). For more information, visit www.milcc.org. The postmark deadline for MILCC scholarship applications is January 31,

2012. When applying for a MILCC scholarship, the applicant must submit a completed IBLCE exam application at the same time and all IBLCE exam eligibility requirements must be completed before submitting the exam and scholarship applications.

Applying for the Exam

IBLCE in the Americas is implementing an online application process in 2012. This process will be implemented incrementally over the coming year and part of the process will be online and the remainder by paper forms.

Application Review & Audit

All applications are reviewed for exam eligibility and a percentage of applications are randomly chosen for audit. The audit process involves a more detailed review of the documentation that supports the information provided on the application form. Therefore, all applicants are expected to provide the supporting documentation with their printed forms and payment. If chosen for audit and some of the supporting documentation is missing, you will be charged an Incomplete Application fee.

If application review shows that the applicant does not meet all requirements, eligibility to take the exam will be denied and the applicant will be notified in writing. The ineligibility notification will inform the applicant regarding how they may appeal the decision. Ineligible applicants will receive a partial refund of the exam fees paid.

Exam Site Locations

IBLCE will be expanding the use of computer-based testing (CBT) worldwide in 2012. Not all exam languages will be offered by the CBT format, instead they will be offered by the traditional paper and pencil (P&P) format.

Arrangements are being made to accommodate exam candidates who plan to attend the 2012 ILCA conference in Orlando, Florida.

The following table summarizes the exam format that will be used in some of the countries served by IBLCE in the Americas.

- **Please Note:** For the countries/locations that are not listed in the following table, P&P exam sites will be established on an as-needed basis.
- **Also note that** American and British English exams in Canada will be in paper and pencil format.
- **What about exam languages not listed below?** If the language you need is listed under the Exam Languages section of this supplement, IBLCE in the Americas will make arrangements for a paper and pencil exam site for you. For example, if you need to take the Korean translation of the exam, please indicate this on your application. IBLCE staff will be in touch to make arrangements for your exam site location.

Appointments at computer-based testing centers are on a first-come, first-served basis. Early registrants are more likely to get appointments at the test center of their choice. Exam fees will not be refunded on the basis of being unable to make an appointment at a CBT test center convenient to you.

All CBT exams will be administered through Pearson VUE test centers and availability of appointments at these test centers is on a first come, first served basis. The sooner your application to take the IBLCE exam is received and approved, the sooner you will be able to register for a seat at a Pearson VUE test center.

Pearson VUE will open registration for CBT appointments on February 1 and a block of appointments has been reserved for IBLCE exam candidates. On May 1, 2012, the reserved block will

expire; therefore, after May 1, it may be more difficult to make an appointment at the computer-based testing center of your choice. You are advised to apply for the 2012 IBLCE exam as soon as you can so that you can maximum your options for CBT test center appointments. Early registrants for CBT test centers seats are more likely to get appointments at centers convenient to them.

- **Please Note:** Exam fees will not be refunded on the basis of being unable to make an appointment at a CBT test center convenient to you.

In Canada, the American and British English translations of the 2012 exam will be offered in paper and pencil format only.

If you are planning to attend the 2012 International Lactation Consultant Association (ILCA) conference in Orlando, Florida USA, please be assured that arrangements are being made to accommodate all exam candidates who want to take the exam following the conference. You can be confident that you will be

able to attend the conference and stay in Orlando to take the 2012 exam. Details will be provided in your exam eligibility notification letter.

In Canada, the American and British English translations of the 2012 exam will be offered in P&P format only.

The following list shows the planned P&P exam sites where American and British English translations of the 2012 exam will be offered in Canada. P&P exam sites in Canadian locations other than those listed below are not guaranteed. Establishment of additional sites will be based upon an evaluation of the number of exam candidates requesting a different location. If you were hoping for an exam site in a Canadian location that is not on the list below, please contact us at iblce@iblce.org before submitting your application.

Exam Language

Each year, the IBLCE exam is translated into a number of languages. Final availability of any translation is based upon demand and the availability of suitable translators. The 2012 IBLCE exam will be offered in the following languages.

Exam Eligibility Notification

Eligible exam candidates will be notified by mail. The notice will include information about how to make appointments at CBT test centers or will include information about the location of your P&P exam site; the exam day schedule; information about what to bring to the exam; the Web Code that will allow you to see your Pass/Fail exam results via a website directory; etc. **Be sure to put this information in a safe location.**

Notification of Exam Results

Official exam results will be mailed in mid to late October. Pass/fail results will be provided on the Americas website and you will be able to access your pass/fail results by using the Web Code provided in your eligibility notification.

Application Forms

The **first step** in the process of applying for recertification by exam in 2012 is to complete a printed “Recertification by Exam Report” form. This printed form captures some contact information, as well as your response to required questions and terms and conditions that must be signed via an original signature. This printed form can be found on the next page of this supplement.

The **second step** requires completion of an online form called “2012 IBLCE Recertification by Exam: Americas. When filling out this online form, you will need to refer to the printed form that you completed. After completing the online form, you will receive a confirmation email that includes all of the responses that you provided on the online form.

For the **third step** in the process, place the completed printed form from Step 1 above, completed Recertification by Exam Payment form and payment in a large envelope and mail the envelope to the address on the Recertification by Exam Payment Form, keeping in mind the postmark deadlines listed below. Applications that are postmarked after these dates are subject to additional fees and/or denial. Please pay the recertification exam fee based upon the date that you mail your envelope to IBLCE in the Americas.

- February 29, 2012 is the last postmark date for the February 28 discounted fee.
- April 30, 2012 is the final postmark date for the 2012 exam.

Please allow 4-6 weeks for IBLCE staff to notify you by email that your application has been received.

For candidates taking the exam in computer-based testing (CBT) format, the **fourth step** will be to register for an appointment at the CBT test center. Details about this will be provided in your exam eligibility notification letter.
